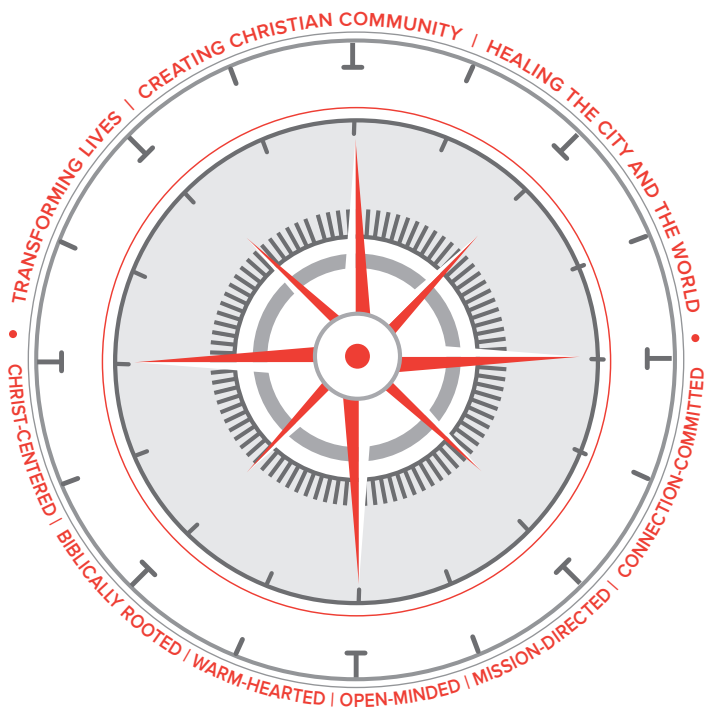

The Chapel Choir sings almost every Sunday with an 8 a.m. rehearsal before the 8:30 Chapel service. This is a mixed SATB group of 8-12 singers. The repertoire is a mix of sacred classical and hymn-based music. No auditions, but must sight read.

The Chancel Choir provides music for the 11 a.m. traditional service in the Sanctuary and in special concerts and events featuring performances of major religious works. 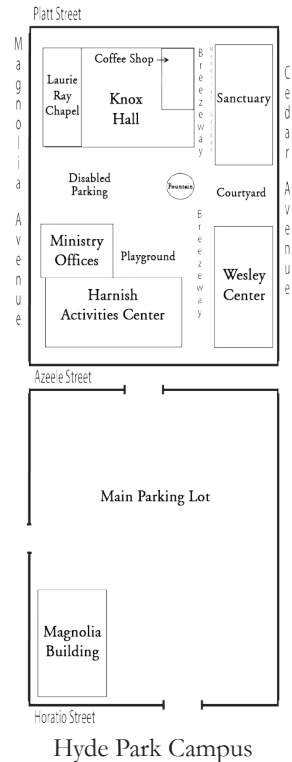
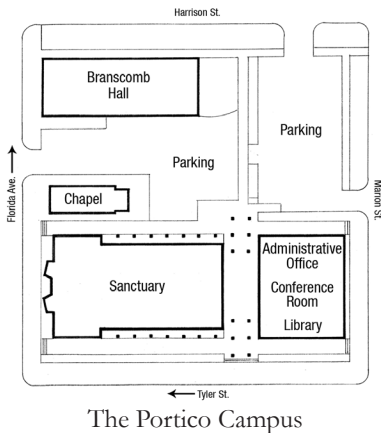
