

COLD WEATHER SHELTER RULES

The Cold Weather Shelter opens at 6:00 pm and closes at 7:00 am

Guests:

- must complete a registration process upon entering the facility
- may get face masks at the registration table
- may smoke/vape outside the building ONLY until 9 p.m.
- will not be readmitted if they leave the building after 9 p.m.
- may not bring or use alcohol or drugs, inside or outside the building
- may not bring any weapons inside the building
- are welcomed on the main floor but are not allowed on the stages or kitchen areas
- must sleep in their gender specific areas. Couples wishing to remain together may sleep in the dining area.
- Who are transgender may sleep in the area in which they are most comfortable
- are asked to help keep the facility clean pick up trash & wipe down mats
- will be asked to leave if they are fighting, using abusive language, or being disruptive
- will be asked to leave if they are stealing others' property, <u>inside or outside</u> the building
